Ontario's GDP and Exports

- Output/GDP has grown steadily over the past 8 years
- Value of International export of goods increased 70% &
- Constitutes an increasingly important portion of GDP

- Therefore as a proportion of Ontario's output has become more significant: <u>26% in 2016</u>

Total exports declined largely due to the fall of exports to the U.S.

Total imports increased largely due to an increased dependence on Chinese imports.

Top 5 export and import products were unchanged from the previous year.

China surpassed Mexico as the #3 most important exporting destination for Ontario.


